Rotary's topic this year is "Rotary Shares." Obviously we share funds, but also we share: love, fellowship, knowledge and hope.

Dave Ballestero and Dave Roberts showed a video about the need of the HIV orphans in Africa. DG O'Meara and a team of six district 5340 reps visited District 9270 in South Africa. There are 12 million orphans in Africa, and 850,000 in District 9270.

Rotarians have several projects to aid: food collection and delivery, help with daycare centers and activities. Another need is with the clinic and hospital. There are only two pediatricians available to treat 00 children daily. Rotary 5340 also is actively working with Districts 9200 in East Africa, 2100 in northern Mexico, and 4400 in Ecuador.
