Today's Jewish Family Service has a budget of 10 million dollars and a professional staff that administers 50 programs. Some of these include three senior centers which offer books, movies, companionship, and opportunities to serve. They have a resettlement program which aided 2500 Katrina evacuees. For 35 years they have furnished Kosher meals through their mobile service. Their credo: Jewish Family Service - one source for a lifetime of help.
